NOTES:

1. This Price List applies to foreign citizens and stateless persons enrolling in doctoral degree programmes on a tuition-fee basis in the 2026–2027 academic year.
2. The tuition fee established by this Price List is the basic tuition fee for one academic year of study under the relevant doctoral degree programme.
3. Tuition fees are established in US dollars (USD). The currency of the educational services agreement and the payment currency are US dollars (USD). The procedure and payment deadlines are determined by the agreement, the University's internal regulations, and the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
4. Academic groups (streams) for individual courses are formed by the University taking into account enrolment results, the number of students, the content of the educational programmes, staffing capacity, and the University's organizational capabilities, provided that the requirements of the relevant educational programmes, the required number of academic credits, and the intended learning outcomes are maintained.
5. The cost of retaking courses (modules), taking additional courses (modules) and academic credits to eliminate academic differences, as well as the cost of other additional educational services provided on a tuition-fee basis, shall be determined by separate price lists and/or internal regulations of the University in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the University's Academic Policy.
