The goal of the educational program "Foreign Philology" is the professional training of specialists in foreign philology in demand in the modern labor market, who speak foreign languages at a high professional level and demonstrate knowledge of modern scientific concepts in the field of literary criticism and linguistics, capable of carrying out scientific research in the field of intercultural communication, cognitive linguistics, text discourse, discourse, literary criticism, ready for future pedagogical professional activity in educational and scientific institutions of various types, organizations of intercultural cooperation and the media.

11. EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

Graduates of the educational program must have the following professional competencies (PC):

1.1. in research activities:

- the skill and ability to independently use knowledge and attainments on the basics of the study of the humanities and linguistics, the latest trends and directions in modern theory of linguistics and literary criticism, methodology and methods of the humanities in relation to the tasks of fundamental or applied research of intercultural communication, sociolinguistics, modern problems of linguistics and literary criticism;
- to set an independent formulation of the goal, set the tasks of scientific research in fundamental and applied areas of linguistics and literary criticism and solve them with the help of scientific research and research using the latest domestic and foreign experience and the study of modern technologies and information technologies;
- the ability to master new theories, models, research methods, the skills to develop new methodological approaches, taking into account the goals and objectives of the study; the ability and willingness to professionally compile and draw up scientific and professional documentation, scientific reports, present the results of research work, taking into account the characteristics of the potential audience;

1.3. in organizational and managerial activities:

- the ability to use in-depth specialized theoretical knowledge, practical skills and abilities for the organization of scientific and applied research, the educational process, expert, analytical and consulting activities;
- the ability to freely use modern methods of collecting, processing and interpreting complex linguistic information for setting and solving organizational and managerial tasks, including those outside the immediate field of activity;

1.4. in pedagogical activity:

- ability and skill to use the acquired knowledge in teaching linguistic and humanitarian disciplines (in-depth knowledge of the main schools and trends, ability for professional reflection);
- ability to plan the educational process taking into account the interests, age and individual characteristics of students;
- ability to use innovative, interactive technologies aimed at developing intercultural and communicative competence, developing and socializing the personality of the student by means of a foreign language: gaming technologies, creative technologies, methods of situational analysis ("brainstorming", "synectic storming", the method of key questions, case studies, project work, etc.);
- has phonetic, grammatical and lexical skills characteristic of a professionally oriented sphere of application, expressing their communicative intentions in the process of interaction with representatives of the international community and solving professional and communicative problems;

Key indicators of the Educational program. The standard period for mastering the educational program of the bachelor's degree "Foreign Philology" is 4 years / 3 years (accelerated learning). The program is built on a budgetary and fee-based basis, is practice-oriented, is taught in the state and Russian languages with the inclusion of disciplines taught in English in the basic curriculum.

The main goals and objectives of the development plan with indications of the terms and stages of its development.

The main goal of the development plan of the educational program is its improvement in accordance with the vision, mission and strategies of the university, aimed at training a qualified specialist who receives high-quality professional education and carries out scientific research in the field of intercultural communication, cognitive linguistics, text discourse, discourse, literary criticism, ready for future scientific and pedagogical professional activity in educational and scientific institutions of various types, organizations of intercultural cooperation and the media, as well as possessing high social and civic responsibility, capable of carrying out professional activity in the following areas:

- education and formation of a comprehensively developed personality of the student;
- formation of systematized knowledge in the field of philology;
- organization of the educational process at a modern scientific level;
- professional orientation of training based on modern information technologies;
- implementation of scientific research in the field of intercultural communication, cognitive linguistics, text discourse, discourse, literary criticism.

Uniqueness of the Educational Program: interdisciplinary approach to the development of the program; interactive teaching methods aimed at developing independent learning and self-development skills; development of the program in accordance with the priority development of the scientific sphere at the university; practical focus of this program; guest lectures by practitioners in the field of intercultural communication, cognitive linguistics and literary criticism; continuous process of studying English with a gradual increase in the level of language training with an emphasis on international law.

The development strategy of KAUIR&WL named after Ablai Khan defines the content of "6B02302 Foreign Philology" EP, aimed at training bachelors in the field of intercultural communication, cognitive linguistics, text discourse, discourse, literary studies.

Competitive advantages of the "6B02302 Foreign Philology" EP

Mechanism for forming a plan. When forming the Development Plan of the educational program, curricula for the "6B02302 - Foreign Philology" EP, the experience of implementing similar programs in other universities in Kazakhstan, near and far abroad is taken into account. The curriculum of the educational program was drawn up with the involvement of developers and employers, taking into account the results of a survey of students of the "Foreign Philology" EP (analysis of satisfaction of students and teaching staff, analysis of available and necessary resources for the program, including the material and technical base, etc.). The implementation period of the EP "6B02302 - Foreign Philology" is 01.09.2024 – 01.07.2028.
