10. PROFILE AND EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

The bachelor's degree program "7M02313 - Foreign Philology" is implemented by the Department of Theory of Foreign Philology of KAZUMO named after Abylai Khan and represents a set of basic characteristics of education in the form of a general description of the educational program, curriculum, calendar schedule, work programs of disciplines, programs of educational and industrial practices, assessment parameters, methodological materials, other components included in the curriculum. as part of the educational program. The purpose of the educational program "7M02313 - Foreign Philology" is to train specialists in the scientific and pedagogical field who are able to conduct constructive, professional dialogue in situations of interethnic, interfaith, and international contexts of interaction, to carry out scientific teaching, editorial, translation, cultural, and organizational activities.

The Foreign Philology educational program aims to develop personal qualities among undergraduates, namely the ability to navigate the system of universal values, take into account the value and semantic orientations of various social, national, religious, professional communities and groups in society, be guided by ethical norms that respect the uniqueness of foreign culture; to develop a culture of thinking, the ability to analyze, generalization of information, setting goals and choosing ways to achieve them, mastering the culture of oral and written speech, to develop socio-cultural and intercultural communication skills that ensure the adequacy of social and professional contacts. The program is also aimed at developing such professionally significant qualities as striving for professional self-improvement, high culture, tolerance, stable moral position, logical thinking, accuracy of perception, creative imagination, the ability to conduct constructive, professional dialogue in situations of interethnic, interfaith, international contexts of interaction, to carry out scientific teaching, educational, editorial, translation, cultural and organizational activities.

The model of the educational program of the specialty, as noted above, includes three basic substantive components reflecting the specifics of the proposed educational system (methodological and conceptual, theoretical and professional, technological and educational), which is implemented by the following blocks of theoretical and practical knowledge and skills:

- cognitive
- conceptual block,
- competence
- -based and effective unit.
- the technological and procedural block.
- reflexive correction unit

The program content is presented in modules. The theoretical, methodological, procedural and methodological basis for modeling the scientific and pedagogical activities of doctoral students is a system of methodological principles that represent the core and system-forming factor developed in the Russian methodological science of the new methodology of foreign language education.

11. EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES.

The educational program is aimed at achieving learning outcomes through the formation of key and professional competencies necessary for the training of scientific and pedagogical personnel in the field of higher and postgraduate education, as well as scientific activities. The Master's degree program in Foreign Philology has been developed in accordance with the requirements of the second-level Dublin Descriptors, which assume the following competencies:

1. demonstration of in-depth knowledge and understanding gained at the higher education level, which serve as the basis for the original development or application of ideas, including scientific research in the field of philology;

2. Applying knowledge and skills to solve complex problems in new or unfamiliar situations in interdisciplinary and professional contexts related to the study of languages and cultures;

3. integration of knowledge, analysis of complex linguistic and literary phenomena, formation of reasoned conclusions based on incomplete or limited information, taking into account ethical and cultural aspects;

4. clear and competent presentation of their research, arguments and conclusions to both specialists and a wide audience;

5. the ability to self-study and further professional development.

The proposed program corresponds to the substantive objectives of the educational process, providing comprehensive training for masters of foreign philology.

The curriculum includes disciplines reflecting current trends in linguistics, literary studies, and intercultural communication, as well as the requirements of state educational standards for postgraduate education.

Upon successful completion of this program, the graduate has:

LO1 - possesses the communication skills necessary for successful interaction in a professional environment and an in-depth understanding of the terms and topics of specialization.;

LO2 - develops critical thinking, understanding of the main stages of the development of scientific knowledge for the analysis of philosophical aspects in the context of philological research;

LO3 - develops teaching skills at the higher education level, as well as learns methods and approaches to successfully interact with the learning process;

LO4 - demonstrates effective leadership and educational resource management skills to understand the processes related to the psychological aspects of management activities;

LO5 - operates with the ability of structuring and argumentation of texts, which contributes to the formation of effective written communication skills in an academic environment;

LO6 - possesses modern methods of foreign philological research for the development of scientific competence and the ability to analyze linguistic and literary phenomena;

LO7 - comprehends the theoretical understanding of the relationship between language, cognitive linguistics

and cultural characteristics in the process of intercultural interaction;

LO8 - uses the skills of comparative analysis of literary traditions and literary evolution in various cultural contexts;

LO9 - uses modern digital technologies to improve the effectiveness of the educational process and interaction with students;

LO10 - analyzes media content in cross-cultural communication situations for proper coverage of the material, implementing the skills of analyzing and perceiving media content in various cultural frameworks;

LO11 - explores the relationship between linguistic phenomena and cognitive processes using modern theoretical approaches;

LO12 - identifies essential principles of human-oriented education for the application of an anthropocentric approach in educational practice;

LO13 - uses modern technologies to digitalize education for deeper and more interactive study of artistic works; LO14 - studies and analyzes the basic laws of pedagogical science, establishes their interrelation, making conclusions and generalizations; freely explains the ways of using pedagogical technologies in new conditions and determines the expected results from the available data, being active in relation to changes and introduces innovations to improve the educational and educational process;

LO15 - has a holistic understanding of the most significant theoretical concepts, empirical research and basic principles of psychology with an analysis of psychological and pedagogical phenomena in the educational process in managing one's own professional growth and developing competence for effective teaching

The main indicators of the OP. The standard period for mastering the educational program of the scientific and pedagogical master's degree in Foreign Philology is 2 years. The program is based on a budget and fee-based basis, is practice-oriented, and is taught in English, Kazakh, and Russian. The training within the program is based on a modular basis. Module 1 usually consists of 30 credits. During one semester, the student's academic load cannot exceed 2 modules. The final state certification of students is carried out in the form of defending master's theses.

The main goals and objectives of the development plan, indicating the timing and stages of its implementation The main goal of the plan for the development of the Foreign Philology educational program is to improve it in accordance with the mission, vision and strategy of the university. The program is aimed at training highly qualified specialists in the field of foreign languages and cultures with a solid theoretical foundation, methodological competence, the ability for intercultural communication, research activities and pedagogical practice. Modern conditions of globalization require specialists who speak foreign languages at a professional level, possess analytical and critical skills, are able to conduct scientific work and publish in international scientific journals. The educational program "Foreign Philology" prepares masters who are able to conduct professional activities in the following areas:

- development of a well-rounded personality of a student with a broad humanitarian outlook;

- formation of deep and systematic knowledge in the field of linguistics, literary studies and intercultural communication;

- organization of the educational process based on advanced scientific and pedagogical methods;

- the use of modern digital technologies in the educational process;

- development of scientific research in the field of philology, linguistics and literary studies;

- preparation for independent scientific activity, including writing and defending a master's thesis;

- publication of scientific articles in peer-reviewed journals and participation in international scientific conferences.

The uniqueness of the educational program

– An interdisciplinary approach to the formation of the curriculum, including elements of linguistics, literary studies, intercultural communication and pedagogy.

- Interactive teaching methods focused on the development of critical thinking, research and analytical skills, as well as independent learning.

- The practical orientation of the program, which provides undergraduates with methods of teaching foreign languages, professional translation and interpretation, and skills in working with various types of texts.

- Regular guest lectures and master classes from leading experts in the field of philology, translation and international communications.

- Development of research activities, including writing scientific articles, participating in conferences, preparing a master's thesis, and scientific expertise on topical issues of philology.

- Continuous learning of foreign languages, paying special attention to academic writing and publishing activities.

Educational program development strategy

The development of the educational program "Foreign Philology" is carried out in accordance with the strategic priorities of the KAZUMO named after Abylai Khan. The program is aimed at training specialists capable of working in the fields of education, scientific research, translation, international organizations and cultural projects. The main directions of the strategy:

- improving the curriculum, taking into account global trends in linguistics and philology;

- active implementation of digital educational technologies and distance learning;

- Strengthening international cooperation through academic mobility, joint research projects and participation in international conferences;

- development of a system of academic support for undergraduates and teachers, including professional development programs and internships;

- strengthening research activities: support for student research projects, publication of articles in leading international journals, work with scientific databases (Scopus, Web of Science), organization of scientific seminars and conferences.

The competitive advantages of the Foreign Philology program are the university's high reputation at the national and international levels.

- Fixed tuition fees and a well-developed scholarship system.
