Annotation

The purpose and objectives of the educational program:

Preparation of masters, multilingual, modern, competitive specialists-Orientalists who speak one of the Eastern and Western languages, who know the history, economy, politics and culture of the region of specialization, able to carry out professional activities in different directions.

- development of personal qualities of undergraduates, formation of General cultural (universal) competences;
- formation of professional competences in the field of Oriental studies;
- organization of the educational process in Oriental studies at the modern scientific level;
- implementation of scientific research.
- ensuring high-quality professional training of graduates capable of conducting professional activities in all areas of interaction with the countries and peoples of the East in accordance with the regional specifics of the study of East Asian countries and the needs of the local labor market;
- formation of a system of key competencies, as well as General scientific and special knowledge, skills and abilities of Orientalists in the field of Oriental studies;
- development of methods of physical, spiritual and intellectual self-development, formation of psychological literacy, culture of thinking and behavior.

Training of multilingual, modern, competitive specialists-Orientalists on the basis of domestic science is necessary for constant monitoring and forecasting of possible and real threats from radical groups, organizations or countries. We should be prepared to mediate in hot spots in the region, within the Greater Middle East and even more globally to resolve religious and ethnic conflicts. Specialists of the new formation will take an active part in the expansion of diplomatic and cultural ties with the Eastern neighbors.

The need to prepare masters in the program "Foreign Asia" is dictated by the demand for specialists in the field of Oriental studies, who know the history of the country, its economy, culture, modern socio-economic situation, political system, political culture, cultural and religious traditions, foreign policy and many other aspects of modern socio-political development of the East in the context of globalization.

The development of Oriental studies as a science was associated with the practical interest of Western countries in the study of the language, history and culture of the peoples of the East. Lack of knowledge in the field of Oriental studies leads to the formation of a distorted view of the East. In connection with the ongoing changes, Kazakhstan Orientalists need to choose the methodological version of the analysis, their own tools for studying the problems of the East and to increase the level of training of qualified and competitive Orientalists to establish diplomatic and cultural contacts with Eastern neighbors.

In the conditions of integration of Kazakhstan's society into the world economic and educational space, it seems timely to develop an educational program for the training of scientific personnel capable of training highly qualified professional specialists in the field of Oriental studies. Educational master's program developed in KazUIR&WL, will be aimed at studying the General patterns of development of the East, in particular future specialists study history, religion, culture, international relations, Economics, politics and society of the East.

In connection with the change in world interaction and Kazakhstan's entry into the world space as an independent entity, domestic Orientalists need to develop a methodological version of the analysis and their own tools for studying the problems of the East.

This master's program will prepare the basis for further research activities of graduates - masters, both in our country and in foreign research centers.

The master's educational program in the direction of Oriental studies, developed at the faculty of Oriental Studies on the basis of the state educational standard, involves

fundamental theoretical training of undergraduates, a comprehensive analysis of modern processes in the modern East. The program is based on new educational technologies, a comprehensive study of the world experience of scientific and practical reflection of social forms and processes. As a result, undergraduates master the interdisciplinary analytical apparatus, which allows to study the history of development of Eastern countries and modern processes in the East at the professional conceptual level.

A distinctive feature characterizing the content of training is the connection between theoretical training, social and practical knowledge and skills of expert-analytical, project and consulting work. Considerable attention in the training program is given to specific work with different methods of analysis.

The main emphasis in the specialized educational program is made on the development of the ability of scientific and critical analysis of modern processes, including such elements as domestic policy, the evolution of the foreign policy of the studied countries, as well as the processes of culture, economy, history, modernization, transformation and globalization on the example of the studied countries.

In General, the master's program is aimed at deepening social and humanitarian knowledge and international specialization of undergraduates, serious preparation for independent research in the field of Oriental studies.

16. CONTENT OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

16.1 GENERAL STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAM

The educational program is usually designed for four academic years of study. The academic year is divided into 2 semesters, lasting 15 weeks. Training under the program is carried out on a modular basis. The full academic load of one academic year corresponds to at least 60 academic credits and corresponds to at least 1800 academic hours for one academic year. At the same time, within one semester, the student masters at least 30 academic credits. The final certification of students is carried out in the form of: passing the state exam and defending a master's thesis. The final certification is 12 academic loans. The purpose of the final certification is to evaluate the learning outcomes and key competencies achieved upon completion of the study of the educational program.

The main results of a master's thesis are presented in at least one publication or one presentation at a scientific and practical conference.

The defense of the master's thesis includes the preparation of the master's thesis, its design and defense procedure.
