Examination procedure. The entrance examination for doctoral study on on Educational Program «8D023 02 Foreign philology» «8D023 Languages and Literature». The content of the doctoral program covers the following issues: Germanic, Roman and Oriental languages which are considered in the linguistic, linguistic-typological and linguoculturological aspects:

- 1. The current status and modern development trends of philological science based on the modern intercultural communicative theory of foreign language education.
- 2. The main aspects of linguistics at the turn of the $20^{th} 21^{st}$ centuries. Linguistic typology.
- 3. General typological characteristics of Germanic, Romance and Oriental languages and their systematic structural peculiarities.

Examination topics include the basic concepts and terminology of modern philology, as well as problems and prospects of development and improvement of foreign philology theory and practice in the light of cognitive linguoculturological methodology of foreign language education, as well as methods and techniques of its research.

The preparation basis of the entrance examination cards for doctoral study on the given specialty are the module programs on "General linguistics", "Comparative-historical" and "Comparative - typological linguistics", "Foreign literature", theory and practice related to the German, Roman and Oriental languages studies. Entrance test:

- oral answer to exam questions -50%;
- defense of the research project -40%.
- motivational essay -10%;

Form of exams - mixed: oral and written.

The examination ticket consists of 3 questions:

- 1 question theoretical question;
- 2 question theoretical question;
 - 3 question Research project of the proposed doctoral thesis
- 1. Criteria and parameters for assessing the oral response to exam questions (max 60 points):
 - 1. Completeness of the content of the question 0-10 points.
- 2. The depth of understanding of the content of the question (the ability to analyze and summarize the phenomena of language) 0-15 points.
- 3. Logic of construction and argumentation of the answer, terminological correctness 0-15 points.
- 4. Knowledge and specific methodological definitions of the categories 0-10 points.

Considering the relevance of the learning goals and objectives of the given speciality, this program focuses on the identification of candidates' skills appropriate in doctoral study and the understanding of contemporary issues of foreign philology.

In passing the entry examination on the given specialty, particular emphasis is being put on a theoretical and logical comprehension of foreign philology problems, the ability to analyze and navigate modern trends, approaches and technologies in the sphere of philological education as a specialist of foreign languages, use metalanguage and relevant terminology of modern philology.

I. Methodology in linguistics.

Cognition is as a human activity, its peculiarities and place among other types of human activity (transforming and communicative activities).

Two levels of cognitions: the level of scientific cognition and practical level. Science and its complementary functions to other areas of public consciousness: science and religion; science and art.

Language is as an object of linguistic research. Substantial, functional and pragmatic properties of language. The subject of internal, external linguistics and its

pragma-functional aspects.

The concept of methodology in general (philosophical) and specific scientific

aspects.

Principles, methods and techniques of linguistic research: the principle of cognition as a general approach to the study of the object, method as a general intellectual aspect of knowledge coordinating the researcher's actions; receiving as a kind of researcher's specific action to research a specific language material.

The classification of the principles and methods of linguistic knowledge.

II. Methods and techniques of internal linguistics.

1. Diachronic approach, comparative historical method in linguistics, techniques of external and internal reconstruction. The terms "protolanguage" "archetype", "etymon" - the problem of motivation and nomination. The genetic classification of languages. The "laws" - of linguistic change.

2. Synchronic approach. Idiographic methods: immediate constituent analysis (IC analysis). The distinctive features of phonemes and morphemes as the final components. Distribution analysis and its basic concepts. Method of transformation

IV. Methods and techniques of pragmalinguistics.

Pragmatics is as one aspect of semiotics. The relationship between the statement, the speaker and the context (the situation). The ratio of sign to denote, the ratio of sign to other signs, the ratio of sign to the participants of the speech act. The study of linguistic facts directly into their using. The main problems studied in pragmalinguistics - structure and classification of speech acts and interpretation of the statement

V. Other scientific methods in linguistics.
