Типовая программа по курсу профессионально-иноязычной подготовки специалистов (Модификационная разработка ОП)

Модель образования третьего тысячелетия предопределяется глобальной стратегией устойчивого развития, одной из ключевых направлений которой является современная тенденция глобализации образования и формирование единого образовательного сообщества, где высшее образование призвано выступать прорывной и реально движущей прогресс силой. Программной основой по включению РК в глобализационные процессы в образовании являются системные и масштабные меры по модернизации системы образования в РК, базирующиеся на современной дидактической Концепций прагматизма в образовании, предопределяющие смену линейноуправляемой накопительный парадигмы образования на прагмафункциональную, обеспечивающие профессионально-прикладную проекцию полученных знаний в профессиональные умения в условиях создаваемых конструктивных механизмов взаимодействия сферы труда и сферы образования.

В формировании профессиональной модели современного специалиста, в состав его обязательных и востребованных мировым рынком труда качеств предлагаются для включения такие понятия и требования как «обеспеченность международно-профессионального взаимодействия», «профессиональная иноязычная компетенция», «иноязычно-отраслевая профкомпетенция», «иноязычная деловая коммуникация», профессионально-отраслевая иноязычная лингводидактика» и др.

Предлагаемый комплекс образовательных программ специальности базируется на адаптационной основе международной модели иноязычного образования применительно к национальным условиям Республики Казахстан определяя, таким образом, следующую стратегию и тактику обучения:

- компетентностная базируемость образования и ее оценки по качеству конечного результата;
 - коммуникативно-функциональная направленность;
- уровневая ранжированность предметного содержания и конечных показателей по выделенным стандартизированным типовым уровням обученности и владения языком;

- представленность предметного содержания **в виде** когнитивно-лингвокультурологических комплексов, состоящих из сфер, тем, субтем и типовых ситуаций общения;
- разработанность критериально-параметровой шкалы измерения языковой компетенции и введения на ее основе единого контрольно-оценочного механизма владения языком, проявляющихся в новом конечном результате формировании межкультурной компетенции как способности к межкультурной коммуникации у личности, определяемого как субъект межкультурной коммуникации.

Основная предопределяющая целевую И роль детерминированность ОП (образовательной программы) является организационно-методического функция как документа, структурирующего содержание и объем знаний, формы организации учебного процесса, последовательность и сроки освоения курсов, модулей, средства диагностики успешности обучения, аттестации, результаты обучения, включая формирование компетенций, ведущих к получению академической степени.

Новая ГПРО четко ориентирует высшее образование на современные научно-технолого-производственные потребности, обеспечиваемую образовательными программами «major-minors».

Форматом структурирования профессиональнопредлагается образовательных программ компетентностный базис планирования управления подготовкой управления интегративным специалистов как модель профессиональным отраслевым образованием, который позволит решить вопросы формирования и технология внедрения новых модификаций базовых специальностей, обеспечение содержательной, технологической профессионально-прикладной обеспеченности.

- Предметное содержание по уровню профессиональноориентированной компетенции предполагает введение отраслевого английского языка по каждой специальности, что требует разработки и выпуска учебников по профессионально-отраслевому английскому языку и подготовку обучающих по контентно-идентичным учебным комплексам с общеуниверситетскими кафедрами по предмету профессионально-ориентированный иностранный язык.

- ➤ Polemic discourse: Currently, there are many private companies and businessmen who spend a lot of money on nature conservation.
- > Round table a meeting of environmental experts on the problems of environmental protection.

 - ➤ Discussion: Will Carbon Trading Reduce Global Warming?

 - > Explain why hot shower water turns into steam

- ➤ Analytical report: Compare and contrast physical and chemical properties. Use a Venn diagram to present your results and provide a report.

All cellular metabolic reactions are the interaction of aqueous solutions. In dried cells, metabolism stops. What is the difference between animals that can live on land?
- ➤ Most insects are small. Do you think the small size of insects is an advantage or a disadvantage?
- ➤ Case-study: Amoeba was placed in two flasks: one with spring water and the other with boiled water. In one of the flasks, after a while the amoeba died. How do you explain why the amoeba died in one of the flasks?
- ➤ Situational problem: More than three hundred years ago, the scientist Van Helmont set up an experiment: he put 80 kg of soil in a pot and planted a willow branch in it, having previously weighed it. The willow grew for 5 years without receiving any food, it was only watered with salt-free water. After weighing the willow after 5 years, the scientist found that the weight of the willow increased by 65 kg, and the weight of the soil in the pot decreased by only 50 g. Why did this happen?

(Mary Shelly "Frankenstein", Jane Austen "Pride and Prejudice", Sharlotte Bronte "Wuthering Heights", William Somerset Maugham "The man with the scar", John Galsworthy "The Forsyte Saga")
- ➤ Business game. Imagine that you are the editor of a literary agency. You have to promote 2 new books Lord of the Rings (J.R.R. Tolkien) and The Stars, my Destination (Alfred Bester). Discuss your campaign options with colleagues. What methods would you use to communicate this to your readers? Will they be identical or not? Why? Prepare book reviews.
- ➤ Role-playing game. Game "On the court". Today we are at a court hearing. A case is being heard about a work that negatively affected the development of the child's psyche. Assignment: everyone gets a role and prepares for it (5 min). After that, each person takes part in the trial on behalf of their character.
